Final Things Seminar ...

I am excited about some upcoming programs that will be a real blessing for us. I want to encourage you to participate in these opportunities. The first special program that I want to talk about is the "Final Things" seminar with Dr. Robert Ford. The dates for this seminar are Friday-Sunday, April 30th-May 2nd. Dr. Ford is a member of the faculty in the Sack School of Bible and Ministry at Kentucky Christian University in Grayson, Kentucky. He had spent many years in the preaching ministry before going to KCU. I know you will be impressed with his Bible knowledge and ability to present the material. We will have three sessions in this seminar: Friday night, Saturday morning, and Sunday morning. The topics that Dr. Ford will be discussing include: 'Signs', 'The Judgment', and 'The New Earth.' Consider what the apostle Paul shares with us concerning the Christian and the second coming of Christ.

1 Thessalonians 5:4-5,8-11 – *But you, brothers are not in darkness so that this day should surprise you like a thief. You are all sons of the light and sons of the day. We do not belong to the night or to the darkness. ...But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled, putting on faith and love as a breastplate, and the hope of salvation as a helmet. For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. He died for us so that, whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together with him. Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.*

The day of Christ's return should not surprise us. We need to be aware of the Biblical teaching and know what is happening so we are not surprised when Jesus comes. We need to be encouraging one another with the promise and hope that is ours because of Jesus' second coming.
