Report to Presbytery for February 11, 2012

“For where two or three are gathered in my name, I am among you.” Matthew 18:20

Part of the stated purpose of Presbyterian Women is to “...strengthen the Presbyterian Church (USA).” To implement this resolution, the PWP in the Presbytery of Riverside has created a Nurture Team and held additional gatherings to explore avenues for promoting church growth through intergenerational fellowship, leadership training, study and mission.

Two additional gatherings were added to our annual calendar. Meagan Manas with the National Council Churches of Christ and PW Churchwide for Justice and Peace presented, “Making All Things New,” on April 14th. Forty-five women ranging in age from 15 to 90; representing seven churches attended. A Leadership Renewal and Training Retreat, “Working Together” was held October 8th. Fifty-two women from nine churches attended workshops and worship. Calvary (Riverside) was the venue for both events.

Prayers were lifted up for the PW Global Exchange to India, Susan Skoglund’s trip to Rwanda (PWS) and the July 2012 PW Triennium, “River of Hope,” in Orlando Florida.

Our PWP donated \$13,111.80 for mission in 2011. The next gathering is April 18th at First Presbyterian in San Bernardino.
