

“One Anothering” Verses of the New Testament

Positive Exhortations:

John 13:14 – **Wash one another’s feet**

John 13:34, 15:12 - **Love one another**

Romans 12:5 – Be **members of one another as one body in Christ**

Romans 12:10a – Be **kindly affectionate with brotherly love toward one another**

Romans 12:10 – In honor **give precedence to one another**

Romans 12:16; 15:5 – Be **of the same mind toward another**, according to Christ Jesus

Romans 14:19 – Pursue the things of peace and the things of **building up of one another**

Romans 15:7 – Be **receiving one another**, as the Christ received us to the glory of God

Romans 15:14 – **Admonish one another**, being filled with goodness and knowledge

Romans 16:16; 1 Corinthians 16:20 – **Greet one another** with a holy kiss

1 Corinthians 11:33 – Be **waiting for one another** when you come together to eat

1 Corinthians 12:25 – Have the same **care for one another**

Galatians 5:13 – By love be **servicing as slaves to one another**

Galatians 6:2 – Keep on **bearing one another’s burdens**, and thus fill up the law of the Christ

Ephesians 4:32a – Keep on **becoming kind and compassionate to one another**

Ephesians 4:32b – Keep on **graciously forgiving one another**, even as God in Christ also graciously forgave you

Ephesians 5:19 – Keep on being filled with the Spirit, **speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs**, singing and chanting in your heart to the Lord, giving thanks always for all things to God

Ephesians 5:21 – Keep on **subordinating yourselves to one another** in the fear of Christ

Philippians 2: 2 – Be united in soul, minding the one thing, in humility **esteeming one**

another above yourselves, not looking only to one's own things but also to the things of others

Colossians 3:13 – Put on for yourselves compassion from within, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, long-suffering, bearing with one another, and graciously **forgiving one another**

Colossians 3:16 – Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, in all wisdom, **teaching and admonishing one another** in psalms and hymns and spiritual odes, singing with grace in your heart to the Lord

1 Thessalonians 3:12 – May the Lord make you to increase and abound in **love toward one another and toward all**

1 Thessalonians 4:18 – We shall always be with the Lord, so keep on **comforting one another** with these words

1 Thess 5:11 – God did not appoint us for wrath, but for gaining possession of salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, Who died for us, that ...we should live together with Him. Wherefore **be comforting one another** and building up one another.

1 Thessalonians 5:12-21 – Know those who labor among you, and who are set over you in the Lord and admonish you, and be esteeming them exceedingly in love on account of their work. Be at peace among yourselves,...be admonishing the disorderly, be consoling the faint-hearted, be supporting the weak, be long-suffering toward all. See ye that no one render evil for evil to anyone, but **always be pursuing the good both toward one another and toward all**. Be rejoicing always, be praying unceasingly. In everything be giving thanks. Be testing all things, holding fast to the good.

Hebrews 3:13-14 – Be **exhorting one another every day...**, lest any of you be hardened by the deceit of sin. For we have become partakers of Christ

Hebrews 10:24 – Let us be holding fast the confession of our hope unswerving, for He Who promised is faithful. And let us be **considering one another to incitement of love and of good works**, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together,...but **exhorting one another**

James 5:16 – Keep on **confessing your transgressions to one another and praying for one another**, that ye might be healed

1 Peter 4:8 – Be...sober minded and watchful in the prayers. And before all things have fervent love among yourselves, for “love shall cover a multitude of sins” (Proverbs 10:12).

1 Peter 4:9 – Be **hospitable to one another**, without murmurings.

1 Peter 4:10 – According as each one received a free gift, **minister the same to one another**, as good stewards of the diversified grace of God.

1 Peter 5:5-7 – Ye younger ones, be subject to the elders. And all being subject to one another, gird yourselves with humility; for God “setteth Himself against the proud, but giveth grace to the humble” (Proverbs 3:34). Humble yourselves then under the might hand of God in order that He might exalt you in due time, casting all of your care upon Him, for with Him there is care for you.

1 Peter 5:14 – **Greet one another** with a kiss of love

1 John 1:7 – If we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have **communion with one another**, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin.

1 John 3:11 – Be **loving one another**

Negative Exhortations

Romans 14:13 – Let us therefore **no longer be judging one another**

Galatians 5:26 – **Let us not become vainglorious, provoking one another, envying one another**

Colossians 3:9 – **Cease lying to one another**, since ye have put off the old man with his practices, and have put on the new that is being renewed toward full knowledge according to the image of the One Who who created him, where there is no Greek and Jew, circumcision and uncircumcision, barbarian, Scythian, slave and free, but Christ is all things and in all.

James 4:11 – **Cease speaking against one another**

James 5:9 – **Cease groaning against one another**
