Questions about Deuteronomy 1:1–4:43

1. At the beginning of Deuteronomy, where are the Israelite people, and what are they preparing to do? (1:1-8) What is so important about the land of the Canaanites?
2. Why did God cause the Israelites to wander in the desert for forty years? (1:26–2:7)
3. What events does Moses recall to prove to the people that the LORD is the only true God? (4:1-8,29-40)
4. What must the people of Israel do in order to take the land God promised to give them? (4:1,2)
5. Do you agree or disagree with this statement: "Those who don't study the past are doomed to repeat the mistakes of the past." Explain your opinion. How would such a statement apply to the beginning chapters of Deuteronomy?
