In the months of December, January, Februry and the first of March, we will be in the U.S. doing mission's and Kid's meetings.

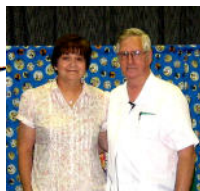
**Please Pray for:**
